

## Fire at Marine Terminal in L.A. Closes Port for the Day

Received from the Los Angeles Freight Brokers and Freight Forwarders Association:

There is currently a fire at a break-bulk terminal in the Port of Los Angeles.

It is not expected that this fire will spread to other container terminals in the area, however the smoke from the fire has impacted terminal operations for the ILWU and CBP and all terminal operations in the Port of Los Angeles are suspended until the air quality is back to acceptable levels.

It is expected that operations may return to normal beginning the second shift today (6.00PM).

As we understand it most Port of Long Beach terminals are not yet affected, but could be should winds shift.
